

## KITTATINNY CAMPGROUNDS RULES & REGULATIONS

**Check-In:** Check-in begins at 2:00pm and ends at midnight. Late arrivals may not be permitted to go to their site and no refunds are given for late arrivals.

**Check-Out:** Check-Out is 1:00pm. Additional charges may apply if your site is not cleared by 1:00pm. If you are taking part in a river or paintball activity, you must clear your site before beginning your activity. Guests may us the facilities after 1:00pm as long as the site has been cleared.

**Quiet Hours:** Quiet hours begin at 11:00pm and continue until 6:00am. All radios must be shut off. Excessive noise after 11:00pm may result in eviction without a refund.

**Loud Noise:** No loud radios, loud talking, barking dogs or loud noise of any kind is permitted at any time of the day. Be considerate of your neighbors. Excessive noise may result in eviction without a refund.

Wristbands: Wristbands are given to everyone in your group and must be worn at all times.

**Car Passes:** The car pass(es) given to you must be displayed on the rearview mirror of all vehicles intending to enter the campground. Vehicles without a pass may be towed at the owner's expense.

Parking: No more than two vehicles are permitted per site. Additional parking is available in the activity fields.

**Speed Limit:** The speed limit throughout the campground is 5 MPH.

**Campfires:** All fires must be kept within the camp fire ring provided at every site.

**Fireworks**: Fireworks, of any kind, are not permitted in the campground and will be confiscated.

Alcohol: Excessive consumption of alcohol may result in eviction without a refund.

**Glass Containers:** Glass containers of any kind are not permitted in the campground. Broken glass pieces left on the site will result in a charge of up to \$100.00.

Litter: Trash cans are provided on every site. Any litter left on a site after departure may result in extra charges.

**Axes, Hatchets, Machetes, Etc:** These items are not permitted in the campground and will be confiscated. Any damage done to a tree will result in a charge of up to \$400.00.

**Firearms:** Firearms of any kind including B.B. guns and paintball guns are not permitted in the campground and will be confiscated. Slingshots are also prohibited.

Tables: There are chained picnic tables provided at each campsite. Moving or damaging the table may result in a charge of \$200.00.

**Pets:** Two pets per site are allowed and must be kept on a leash. It is your responsibility to clean up after your pet. Failure to do so may result in a \$50.00 clean up charge.

Visitors: All visitors must check in at the campground store. There is a \$8 daily visitor charge.

**Cancellation Policy**: Cancellations require seven days advance notice. Refunds or credits are minus a \$10.00 processing fee. After seven days, no refunds are issued. If you paid for people and they don't show up, no refunds are given. No exceptions. Furthermore, camping is an outdoor experience; we do not give refunds for the discomfort of nature.

Site Requests: We will do our best to get you the site that you want but cannot guarantee it. All sites are subject to change without notice.

**Liability and Insurance:** Kittatinny Campgrounds, Inc. is not responsible for personal injuries or damage to or loss of property, whether by fire, theft, weather, wind, fallen trees or otherwise. Campsite facilities and grounds at Kittatinny Campgrounds are used at your own risk.

## RULES

- Checkout time is 1:00pm. Campers taking river trips with Kittatinny on the day of departure are welcome to us the facilities after their trip; however, campsite must be vacated before going on the river.
- Cars must be registered at the office and car passes displayed in the windshield. Speed limit is 5MPH.
- Quiet hours are from 11pm to 6am. All audio devices must be off except when using headsets. Campfires must be allowed to go out and conversation must be quiet. Excessive noise or rowdiness will result in eviction without refund.
- Illegal drugs or excessive use of alcohol are prohibited.
- Campfires must be kept small and in fire ring only.
- Damage to trees, shrubs, or other property is strongly prohibited. Do not nail, cut or carve trees or shrubs.
- Fireworks, firearms, BB, pellet, paintball guns and slingshots are prohibited.
- Pets must be on a leash and not left unattended. No large, noisy or vicious pets are allowed and owners are responsible for cleanup after the pet. One pet per site.
- Visitors must register at campground office.
- Swim at your own risk. Beware of sudden drop offs and strong currents. Children under 16 must be supervised by an adult.
- Refunds are not given due to discomforts of nature or early departure.
- Additional rules are posted at the campground and must be obeyed.

## READ CAREFULLY - LIABILITY RELEASE

In consideration of <u>KITTATINNY CAMPGROUNDS</u>, INC and/or <u>RIVER BEACH CAMPSITES</u>, INC. and/or <u>JONES PARTNERS</u>, <u>L.P.</u>, <u>KITTATINNY CANOES INC</u>, and/or <u>KITTATINNY CANOE CORP</u>, and/or (hereinafter, as applicable, individually and collectively referred to as "Lessor") furnishing services and/or camping facilities, and/or equipment to enable me to participate in camping or other outdoor recreational activities, (hereinafter, individually and collectively referred to as "outdoor recreational activities"), I agree to follows I fully acknowledge that:

- A. Risk and dangers exist in camping or in my use of camping equipment or facilities and my participation in any other outdoor recreational activity;
- B. My participation in such activities and/or use of such equipment may result in injury or illness including, but not limited to, bodily injury, disease, strains, fractures, partial and/or total paralysis, loss of life or other ailments that could cause serious disability;
- C. These risks and dangers may be caused by negligence of the owners, officers, employees, servants or agents of Lessor, the negligence of the participants, the negligence of others, accidents, breaches of contract, the forces of nature or other causes. These risks and dangers may arise from foreseeable or unforeseeable causes; and
- D. By my participation in these outdoor recreational activities and/or use of equipment, I assume all risks and dangers and all responsibility for any losses and/or damages, that are not directly attributable to gross negligence on part of the Lessor or anyone affiliated with the Lessor.

I on behalf of myself, my personal representatives and my heirs hereby voluntarily and knowingly agree to remise, release, forever discharge, hold harmless, defined and indemnify Lessor and it's owners, employees, agents and servants, barring gross negligence on part of the Lessor, from any and all claims, actions, causes of actions, suits, judgments, claims and demands for bodily injury, property damage, loss of life and/or loss of services, in law or equity, that may in any way or manner arise from any accident, incident, happening circumstance or activity, or otherwise may arise out of the use of the equipment or my participation in any other outdoor recreational activities. Barring gross negligence on part of the Lessor, I specifically understand that I am releasing, discharging and waving any claims or actions that I may have presently or in the future for ordinary negligent acts or human error by Lessor and/or the owners, agents, officers, servants or employees of Lessor.

Barring gross negligence of the Lessor, I acknowledge that I am using, occupying or renting the equipment and/or engaging in the outdoor recreational activities at my own risk and I assume any and all risks of bodily injury, loss of life, loss of or damage to property, loss of services or any other loss which arises directly or indirectly from the use, occupation or rental of the equipment or engagement in any outdoor recreational activities. Any claims or dispute arising from my participation in Lessors activities or Lessors equipment shall be venued in the Pike County Court of Common Pleas of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or the Sullivan County Supreme Court of the State of New York. The above agreement shall be binding on my heirs, successors, assigns, administrators and executors.

This Waiver and Release of Liability is made by me in order to induce Lessor to provide equipment or other recreational activities to me.

I HAVE READ THE ABOVE WAIVER AND RELEASE AND BY SIGNING IT AGREE IT IS MY INTENTION TO EXEMPT AND RELIEVE LESSOR, IT'S OWNERS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS AND SERVANTS, BARRING GROSS NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE AFOREMENTIONED FROM LIABILITY FOR PERSONAL INJURY, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR LOSS OF LIFE CAUSED BY GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR HUMAN ERROR. I AGREE TO OBEY ALL RULES ATTACHED OR POSTED OR CONVEYED TO ME. I HAVE COMPLETELY READ AND UNDERSTAND THE ABOVE AGREEMENT.
