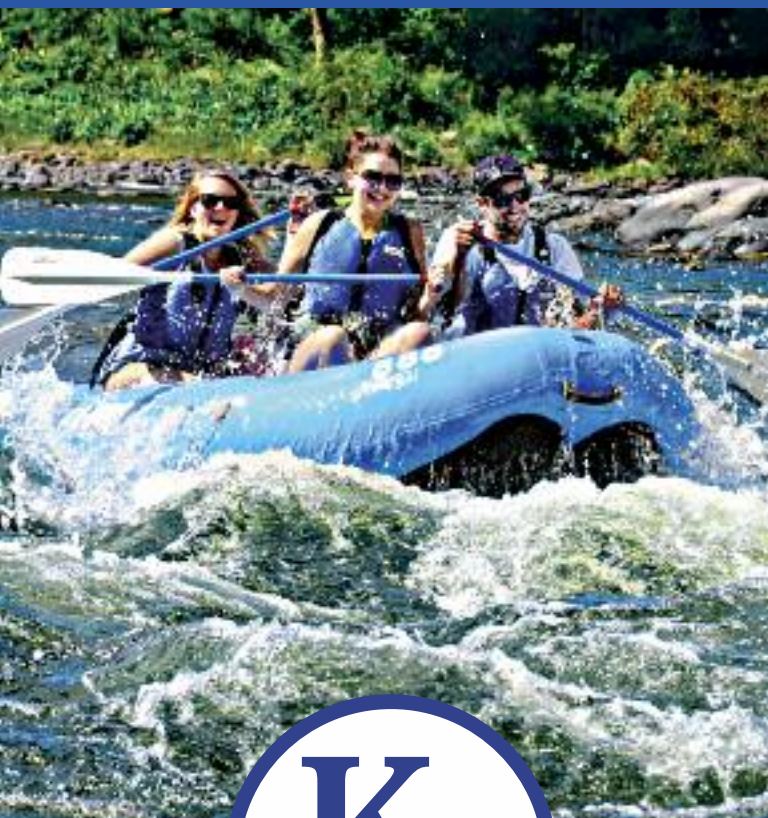

RIVER FAQ

What to Wear

River shoes or sneakers. Bathing suits, shorts, and hats for warm weather. Performance-wicking fabric should be worn in cooler temperatures to keep warm.

What to Bring

Sunglasses with straps, waterproof sunscreen, litter bags, picnic lunch, water and drinks, and a dry change of clothes. There is room for coolers in canoes and rafts, and room for small soft coolers in kayaks.

What about- alcohol, drugs, and littering

Know your limits, and stay within them. Glass containers are not allowed. The National Park Service and other law enforcement agencies do not recommend mixing boating and drinking; they may fine, arrest and remove people from the river who litter, are under the influence of alcohol, illegal drugs, or display disorderly conduct. Your cooperation is your responsibility.

Are there age limits?

People of almost any age can enjoy a Kittatinny river adventure. Young children or any child who is not comfortable in moving water should not be on the river. It is your responsibility to assess the risks and dangers of allowing a child under your care on the river. We have no way of knowing your child's swimming or other abilities. Children must weight at least 40 lbs to be properly fitted with a personal flotation device.

RIVER INFO

Overnight trips Overnight continuous paddle trips with free camping. Call for details, price for rental overnight is per person per day.

Lackawaxen River Whitewater trips are available on dam release and high water days. We run river trips on 2 rivers. Paddle 2 rivers for the price of 1! See trip selection box for description.

Reservations

Reservations are recommended to assure availability. Please call 800-FLOAT-KC for trip planning and to make your reservation. A 50% deposit is required to secure your reservation. Discounts are available for booking ahead. Organizational checks, Mastercard, Visa, American Express and Discover accepted anytime.

Damage Release Option

\$2.00 per person per day. Must be taken by everyone in your group to apply. Releases you from charges for damages to watercraft due to normal use. Excludes willful damage or loss of paddles and vests.

Rain Checks

If it is raining at Kittatinny during your time of departure and forecasted to continue, a rain check can be issued for a later date during the same season. You must call up to 2 hours prior to your scheduled departure time to rain check your reservation. There are no rain checks available for camping.

Cancellations

All river reservations may be canceled up to seven days prior to receive a refund of your deposit minus a \$10.00 processing fee.

Safety

For your safety, you must wear a life vest at all times on the river and while swimming. You must fully understand that any outdoor activity poses inherent hazards and risks, including but not limited to serious and permanent injury and death; and in addition, that adverse weather and river conditions can pose additional hazards and risks. Through your participation, you are knowingly assuming the risk arising out of that activity. We do not assume liability for personal injuries or death or for loss of or damage to personal property. Children must be at least 40 lbs to be properly fitted with a personal flotation device. All participants are required to sign a Acknowledgement of Risk form prior to their trip.

Relax around a campfire with your friends and family at the finest riverfront campsites along the Delaware River! We offer two campgrounds in two different states, both are nestled along the scenic Delaware River and are located 40 minutes apart.

Kittatinny Campgrounds in Barryville, NY is the premier campground on the Delaware River. Kittatinny is located in the Catskill Mountains on more than 250 rugged acres. Camp riverfront, along a mountain stream or in forested campsites. Features include on site outdoor activities such as Delaware River trips, zipline rides, paintball, a stocked trout stream, pavilion, laundromat, badminton courts, horseshoes, hiking trails and fully stocked camp store with deli.

River Beach Campsites in Milford, PA features prime riverfront tent camp sites and RV sites in the Pocono Mountains. It is close to major highways and convenient to both calm and whitewater river trips. Features include river islands to explore, waterfront campsites, RV area, Wi-Fi, laundromat, a camp store, canoe and kayak sales. Historic sites, fine restaurants, antique shops, waterfalls, and hiking trails nearby.

Dual Racing ZIPLINES

THIS ADRENALINE FILLED RIDE WILL THRILL THE ZIP OUT OF YOU!

Our Dual Racing Zipline is one of the largest Big Zips in the US! Drop 36 stories from the top of our own private mountain. Zip above the treetops, 150 feet in the air while taking in the magnificent bird's eye view of the Delaware River. Depending on participant's weight speeds of 40-60 MPH are reached.

- **Ride is open to riders ages 8 and up.**
Must be between 60 and 250 pounds to ride.
- **Ziplines open mid-April into November**
Weather permitting. Call for availability.
- **What to Bring** Closed-toe shoes, strapped footwear, appropriate clothing, and sunglasses are recommended.

All participants are required to sign an acknowledgement of risk form prior to riding. Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian's signature.

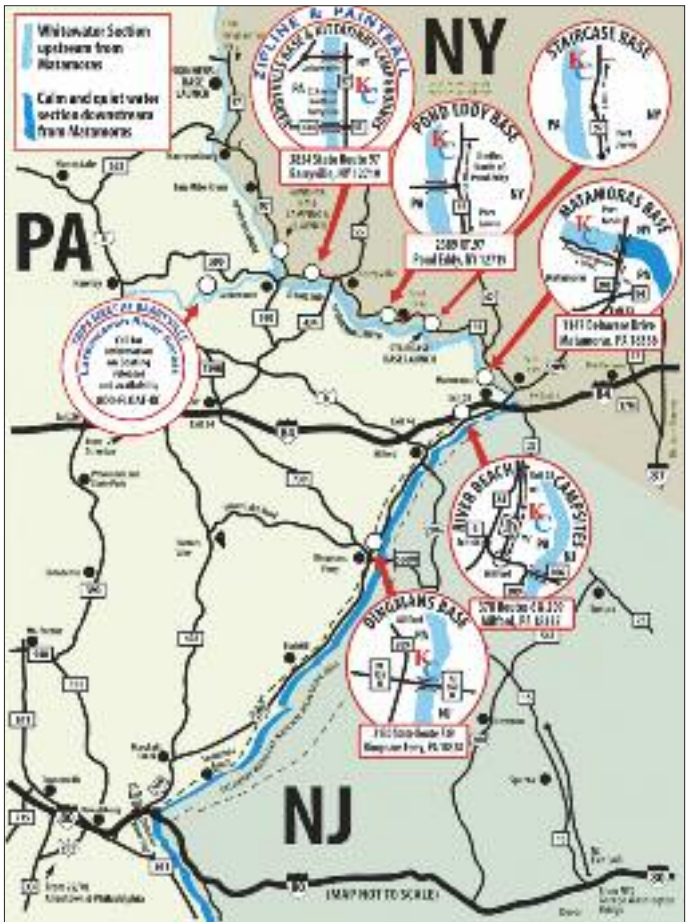

- Camouflage suits are available for \$7.00.
Quantity discounts on paintball purchase.
- **What to Bring:** Drivers license or ID, rugged footwear, appropriate clothing recommended. Paintball open mid-April through October, weather permitting.

TO POND EDDY BASE

2389 Rt. 97, Pond Eddy, NY 12770

FROM NY & NJ: 80W to NJ Exit 34B, 15N to Rt. 206N, across Milford Bridge onto 209N*, turn right at light in Milford, follow 209N to Port Jervis, NY. Turn left at 2nd light onto 97.** Go 14 miles to Pond Eddy Base, 21 miles to Barryville Base and Kittatinny Campgrounds (2.5 miles N of village of Barryville.)

FROM POCONOS: 80E to Exit 309 onto Rt. 209N, Follow from * above.

FROM RT. 23: Rt. 23 N to Port Jervis, 6W 2 miles thru Port Jervis; take 97, follow from ** above.

FROM I-84W: to Exit 1 Port Jervis, at ramp's stop sign make a left. At traffic light stay straight on 6W about 2 miles through Port Jervis. Take 97N, follow from ** above.

FROM I-84 E: to Exit 1 Port Jervis, at ramp's stop sign make a right. At traffic light make left onto 6W about 2 miles through Port Jervis. Take 97N, follow from ** above.

KITTATINNY COUNTRY

TO MATAMORAS BASE

1147 Delaware Drive, Matamoras, PA 18336

Obey Local Speed Limits.

FROM NY & NJ: 80W to NJ Exit 34B, 15N to Rt. 206N, across Milford Bridge onto 209N, turn right at light in Milford to village of Matamoras*, turn left on Delaware Drive just before steel bridge. 2.25 miles on right, look for the gray building with the KC logo.

FROM POCONOS: 80E to Exit 309 209N, right at light in Milford, approx. 6 miles, to village of Matamoras, follow* above.

FROM RT. 23: Rt. 23N to I-84W. Exit 53, Matamoras. Right on 209N thru Matamoras, follow from* above.

FROM I-84: I-84 to Exit 53 Matamoras. Take 209N from* above.

FROM NY & NJ: 80W to NJ Exit 34B, 15N to Rt. 206N, across Milford Bridge onto 209N, turn right at light in Milford. Stay on 209N for 2.5 miles, north of Milford on right.

FROM POCONOS: 80E to Exit 309, 209N, turn right at light in Milford. Stay on 209N for 2.5 miles, north of Milford on right.

FROM RT. 23: Rt. 23N to I-84W. Exit 53 Matamoras. Left on 209S about 2.5 miles on left.

FROM I-84: I-84 to Exit 53 Matamoras. Take 209S 2.5 miles. River Beach on left.

TO DINGMANS FERRY BASE

2130 State Route 739, Dingmans Ferry, PA 18328.

(NPS parking fee)

FROM NY & NJ: 80W to NJ Exit 34B. 15N to Rt. 206N. Left turn at Rt. 560W to Dingmans Bridge.

FROM POCONOS: 80E to Exit 309. 209N to Dingmans Ferry. At light, right on 739S. Base on left before bridge. Park on right in NPS lot.

FROM RT. 23: Rt. 23N to I-84W. Exit 53, Matamoras. Left on 209S to Milford, then 8 more miles to light in Dingmans Ferry. Left on 739S to base.

FROM I-84: I-84 to Exit 53 Matamoras. 209S to Milford, then 8 more miles to light in Dingmans Ferry. Left on 739S to base. From Scranton area, Exit 34 to 739S. Approx. 11 miles to base.
