

CABIN RULES

- Check in time is 2:00 P.M. Check out time is 11:30 A.M. Campers that take their river trips with Kittatinny on the day of departure are welcome to use the facilities after their trip; however, the cabin must be vacated prior to your adventure.
- Cars must be registered at the office and car passes displayed in the windshield. Towing will be at the owner's expense if failure to display passes.
- Campers will receive a wristbands when checking in, please wear wristbands at all times.
- Campground speed limit is 5 mph.
- Quiet hours are from 11 p.m. to 9 a.m. All audio devices must be off except when using headsets. Campfires must be allowed to go out and conversation must be quiet. Excessive noise or rowdiness will result in eviction without refund.
- Illegal drugs or excessive use of alcohol are prohibited.
- Campfires must be kept small and in fire ring only.
- Damage to trees, shrubs, or other property is strongly prohibited. Do not nail, cut, or carve trees or shrubs.
- Fireworks, firearms, BB, pellet, paintball guns, slingshots, axes, hatchets, and machetes are prohibited. If these items are found at the campsite, you will be fined.
- Pets are not allowed with cabin rentals. A \$150 cleaning fee plus cost of any damages will be charged for violation.
- Please no littering!
- Glass bottles, containers, or any other glass objects are not allowed.
- Visitors must register at campground office at a cost of \$9.95 per day, guests are issued wristbands & their registration expires at sundown. .
- Swim at your own risk. Beware of sudden drop offs and strong currents. Children must be supervised by an adult. Life vest must be worn at all times. All participants must be able to swim.
- Refunds are not given due to discomforts of nature or early departure.
- Cancellation policy is 14 days prior to the arrival date; guests will receive a refund minus a \$25 processing fee. Cancellations less than 14 days prior reservations can no longer be issued a refund.
- For all river trips- rainchecks can be given if it is raining at Kitattinny at the time in which you call, no more than two hours before your departure time. Rainchecks must be used within the same season that they are given.
- Additional rules are posted at the campground and must be obeyed.
- Smoking is prohibited in cabins, a \$150 cleaning fee plus cost of any damages will be charged for violation.
- Please be advised that cabins hot water heater is only 20 gallons. So use hot water sparingly.
- The charcoal grill is stored on the front porch, it must be moved off the porch before using. Please, DO NOT use the grill on the porch.
- **A damage deposit of \$250 is due & payable at the time of reservation. This deposit will be refunded to your card upon checkout if no damage has been incurred.**

In consideration of KITTATINNY CAMPGROUNDS, INC. and/ or RIVER BEACH CAMPSITES, INC. and/or JONES PARTNERS, L.P., KITTATINNY CANOES INC. and/or KITTATINNY CANOES CORP. and/or, (hereinafter, as applicable, individually and collectively referred to as “Lessor”) furnishing services and/or camping facilities, and/or equipment to enable me to participate in camping or other outdoor recreational activities, (hereinafter, individually and collectively referred to as “outdoor recreational activities”), I agree as follows:

I fully acknowledge that:

1. Risk and dangers exist in camping or in my use of camping equipment or facilities and my participation in any other outdoor recreational activity;
2. My participation in such activities and/or use of such equipment may result in injury or illness including, but not limited to, bodily injury, disease, strains, fractures, partial and/or total paralysis, loss of life or other ailments that could cause serious disability;
3. These risks and dangers may be caused by negligence of others, accidents, breaches of contract, the forces of nature, or other causes. These risks and dangers may arise from foreseeable or unforeseeable causes; and
4. By my participation in these outdoor recreational activities and/or use of equipment, I assume all risks and dangers and all responsibility for any losses and/or damages, that are not directly attributable to gross negligence on part of the Lessor or anyone affiliated with the Lessor.

I on behalf of myself, my personal representatives and my heirs hereby voluntarily and knowingly agree to remise, release, forever discharge, hold harmless, defend and indemnify Lessor and it's owners, officers, employees, agents and servants, barring gross negligence on part of the Lessor, from any and all claims, actions, causes of actions, suits, judgements, claims and demands for bodily injury, property damage, loss of life and/or loss of services, in law or equity, that may in any way or manner arise from any accident, incident, happening, circumstance or activity, or otherwise may arise out of the use of the equipment or my participation in any other outdoor recreational activities. Barring gross negligence on part of the Lessor, I specifically understand that I am releasing, discharging and waving any claims or actions that
